SPARKLING WINES

- 1. Prosecco N.V. – Italy** £20.95
A really interesting Italian sparkling wine. A fragrant light juicy sparkler, with a surprisingly soft texture.
By the glass 125ml £4.15
- 2. Veuve Cliquot Ponsardin N.V. – France** £59.95
Veuve Cliquot Champagne is still inspired by the motto of it's founder, Madame Cliquot; "One quality, the finest"

ROSE WINES

- 3. Matra Hill Cabernet Sauvignon Rose' – Hungary (H)** £16.95
Intense cherry pink colour with a bouquet of red berry fruits of strawberry, blackberry, raspberry. A nicely rounded harmonised wine with excellent fresh fruit, crisp acidity and a prickle on the tongue.
- 4. Discovery Beach Zinfandel – California (H)** £16.95
Vibrant rose' coloured wine with sweet summer fruit flavours. Light, refreshing and easy drinking.

WHITE WINES

- 5. Peregrino Sauvignon Blanc – Chile (H)** £16.95
Full of varietal character with gooseberry, grassy aromas. A beautifully balanced well rounded crisp clean Sauvignon Blanc.
- 6. Pinot Grigio Sanvigilio – Italy (H)** £17.95
The "buzz word" grape variety giving floral aroma & juicy refreshing fruity palate
- 7. Riversdale Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc – New Zealand** £23.95
This Sauvignon Blanc gives you everything you would expect from a Marlborough wine. Loaded with fresh capsicum, gooseberries and nettles – a Classic.
- 8. Finca Chardonnay / Torrente's – Argentina (H)** £16.95
An attractive pale golden wine with a fragrant bouquet of citrus and honey; a fresh fruity flavour.
- 9. Anglesey Chardonnay – Australia** £21.95
A stylish full bodied dry white full of fruit flavours - well balanced and not over oaked.

WHITE WINES CONTINUED

- 10. Kleindal Bouquet Blanc – South Africa (H)** £17.95
An unusual blend of Chenin and Hanepoort grape varieties grown in South Africa; results in an impressive refreshing and fruity medium dry white
- 11. Simonsig Estate Chenin Blanc – South Africa** £20.95
Grapey, fresh and juicy, medium dry with a long clean finish. This is a serious Estate grown Chenin.

RED WINES

- 12. Il Meridione Nero d' Avola Araldica – Italy (H)** £16.95
Sicilian wines just get better and better. This red from the local Nero d'Avola is packed with fruit and yet is sufficiently sturdy to match well with local food.
- 13. Jean d'Alibert Pinot Noir – Vine de Pays V.D.P d'Oc – France** £23.95
Made with 100% Pinot Noir, this wine is elegant with a complex nose dominated by juicy bramble fruit and a very soft palate. It is a spicy character complements red meats and cheese.
- 14. Peregrino Merlot – Chile (H)** £16.95
A gentle textured red wine with nuances of black cherries and herbs.
- 15. Anglesey Shiraz – Australia** £21.95
The name is co-incident! Lovely ripe full red with a hint of liquorice and a soft peppery finish.
- 16. Chateau Leon – France** £27.95
The second wine Chateau Carignan; this wine is a traditional blend of Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc, giving a wine of full, ripe fruit character.
- 17. Finca Shiraz / Malbec – Argentina (H)** £16.95
Malbec produces lively intense wine with raspberry and plum aromas giving a soft fruity easy to please flavour in combination of Shiraz adds a soft bramble fruit, pepper and spice.
- 18. Vista TR Tinta Roriz – Caves Alancia – Portugal** £19.95
This full bodied, spicy red comes from the estate vineyards in the Beiras region of central Portugal. Produced from two local grape varieties, predominantly Tinta Roriz with 15% barrel-aged Touriga Nacional to give extra structure and complexity. It combines a ripe rounded easy to drink style with rich plum and cherry fruit.
- 19. Heredad De Barros Tinto Crianza – Spain** £26.95
This discovery has a vivid red colour, a most unusual bouquet of leather and creosoted oak and a hot spicy ripe fruit flavour.
